Rather than having membership, Common Ground has All In Ministers. An All In Minister is committed to and prioritizes all that is written below. An All in Minister is expected to take responsibility for the mission and vision of Common Ground. Use your skills, your gifting, and your resources to progress Jesus' mission. You are expected to share your opinions and convictions as you are a vital and necessary minister to the whole. You must be ready to serve others, and to be served by others as the Spirit leads.

A Plan A – I share a better way and there is no Plan B.

God's Plan A for the world to hear about His love is that we live a lifestyle of sharing our faith through our actions and words. There is no Plan B. The Bible says in Proverbs 14:12 that, "There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death." We have a better way.
